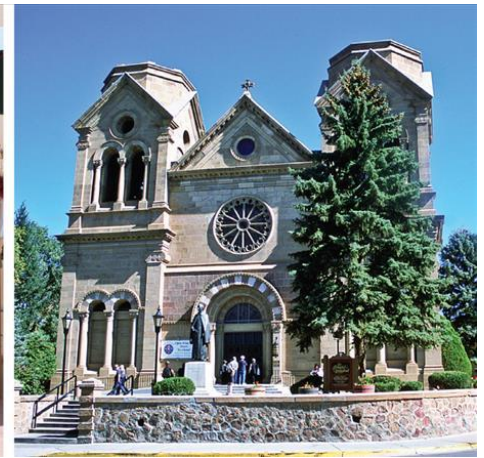

This fascinating history unfolds at the National Museum of Nuclear Science and History where a docent takes you on an intriguing journey that includes the Manhattan Project.
